Between fascination and fear, the light carries an imaginary, a poetry and takes the viewer to travel between the tiny and the very large.

With LLum, Caroline Cornélis (choreographer and dancer) together with Frédéric Vannes (light technician) bring to light what normally remains in the shadow, by exploring on stage the relation between light, dance and movements. Through their complicity, light becomes a precious material of games, interactions and relations and ask to children the following questions : Could I stroke or squash the light ? Could I eat it or touch it ? I think I can definitely dance with it.
