

Oswieçim is a city whose name has been supplanted by the one given to it by the Nazis: Auschwitz. This small town of 40,000 inhabitants which borders the camp has become a museum and seems unable to shake off the weight of the past. This city, which was once inhabited by more than 50% of Jewish people, is now a symbol of the dark part of History. As the last survivors of the concentration camps disappear, the memory of older generations of Poles also disappears. Personal stories are diluted in the great History. What is the relationship between the 2nd and 3rd generations of children and grandchildren of Poles who lived through this period? Confronted to them, how does Julie, granddaughter of two survivors of the Auschwitz camps, feels?

THEATER

LIBRE COURS COMPANY

Libre Cours is a theater company created by Julie Benegmos, author and director, living in Montpellier in 2016. Aneymone Wilhelm is the co-creator of the design and the universe of each projects of the company.

The Libre Cours company took its first steps in 2017 with the creation of the show « L'Oubli » by Julie Benegmos, adapted from the novel by Frederika Amalia Finkelstein.

This first project having been supported by the Collectif en Jeux, the Compagnie Libre Cours has woven a network of solid partners in the Occitanie region, in particular in Montpellier where the director lives.

The particularity of the Compagnie Libre Cours is not to be afraid of the hybridization and the mix of artists and media used to create innovative projects that question the place of the public and its participation in the work.

For her first creation « L'Oubli », Julie Benegmos tries to play a live video game with the public. An animated character is designed especially for the project and a fake video game is projected on stage during the show.

In her second show, Julie Benegmos continues her first creation and writes the second chapter to the first show: « Après l'Oubli ».


This time, viewers play a game of bingo live with the actress on set and can change the order of the scenes in the play. This show created for a small number of spectators experiments with a new way of telling a story in a different order each evening depending on the audience by mixing autobiographical narrative, documentary film and live recording on the set.

Today, Julie Benegmos tries to recreate the intimacy of an erotic theater via an "immersive" set installation of the public. At the end of the show, the public experiences an encounter with a client in a striptease booth via a virtual reality headset.

Unafraid of "testing" new media and using new technologies to tell stories, the Company Libre Cours navigates between experimental theatre, documentary theater and fiction.

How and with what tools do we best tell a story? This is what the Compagnie Libre Cours seeks with each new project. Each project is therefore a new adventure towards a world still unknown to the director but which she seizes to transmit stories, experiences and ideas.





APRÈS L'OUBLI AFTER OBLIVION

Theater and Visual Arts Performance 2017

« On the day of my Bat-Mitzvah, for my 12th birthday, the rabbi entrusts me with a mission which gives meaning to my life but which overwhelms me with a duty that is far too great for me. Since that day, I have only swallowed the Shoah. It flows day and night in my veins, through films, stories, novels, trips to Auschwitz and commemorations. I can't get rid of it, even if I try, it always catches me. Like that, without warning at the corner of a street, it will be there again when I thought I had detached myself from it. It sticks to my skin and gnaws at my heart despite all the efforts I have made not to think about it anymore. She accompanies me. I accepted that I couldn't get rid of it »

Julie Benegmos

Take one voice, that of Julie Benegmos, granddaughter of Holocaust survivors, whose mission is to pass on the story of her grandparents. Consider another voice, that of Frederika Amalia Finkelstein, writer, who tries by all means to forget. From their born encounter, After Oblivion; A show that is not afraid to ask questions about the duty of memory and the way in which we transmit history today. At random in a game of bingo, the spectator gradually reconstructs a family story intertwined with the doubts and reflections of a new generation in search of humanity.

The performative installation by Julie Benegmos and Aneymone Wilhelm offers spectators a dive into the world of striptease. Combining fiction, autobiographical narrative and testimonies, Strip: At the risk of loving-it disturbs the social and sexual order of our society, shifting our gaze towards the question of love.

Through interviews and real testimonies of men and women, the project restores the words and points of view of those who one day go through the experience of the strip club. The show is built in three immersive stages that offer viewers the opportunity to step into the shoes of a sex worker - and not a client.
